## The dream of Dolasila

## Multimedia show on the occasion of the $10^{\rm th}$ year of the Cultural Association Fanes.

The legends of the mythic Reign of Fanes, the most ancient cultural heritage in the oral tradition of the Ladin people of the Dolomites mountains are presented through music and video.

The exciting story of princess Dolasila, of the valiant prince Ey de Net, of the wicked sorcerer Spina de Mul and of the ambitious King of Fanes is set in the original locations of the legends deeply bound to the elements and colours of the wild nature of the mountains, inhabited by supernatural creatures. The classical themes in the legends are also presented through the perspective of the protagonist Dolasila and become therefore particularly actual and significant.

The video support is made of parts from the most important productions of the Cultural Association Fanes awarded on international level and of scenic paintings by the artist Rott. The original music from the experimental opera Fanes Poem Musical has won in the category "Music production" at the "Women and Minorities in Media Festival" at the Towson University College of Fine Arts and Communication - Maryland / U.S.A.- in 2012.
